## Transport connections



**L1 Dulwich Hill Line** services operate Monday to Sunday 6am to 11pm (midnight on Friday).

Monday to Friday 7am to 10am and 3pm to 7pm, services depart every 8 minutes.

Saturday, Sunday and Public Holidays 11am to 5:45pm, services depart every 10 minutes, 5:45pm to 9:30pm, services depart every 12 minutes.

Services depart every 15 minutes at all other times.

Check information screens for next estimated service departures.

L2 Randwick Line and L3 Kingsford Line services depart from the nearby Haymarket stop.



Train services depart from Central Station for T1, T2, T3, T4, T8, T9, Intercity and Regional train lines including to the Airport.



Bus services depart from Central Bus Interchange. Bus services operate to the Northern, Eastern, South Eastern, Southern and Inner West suburbs.

Plan ahead and top up or purchase your Opal card online or from an Opal retailer. Visit [transportnsw.info](https://transportnsw.info) for more information.

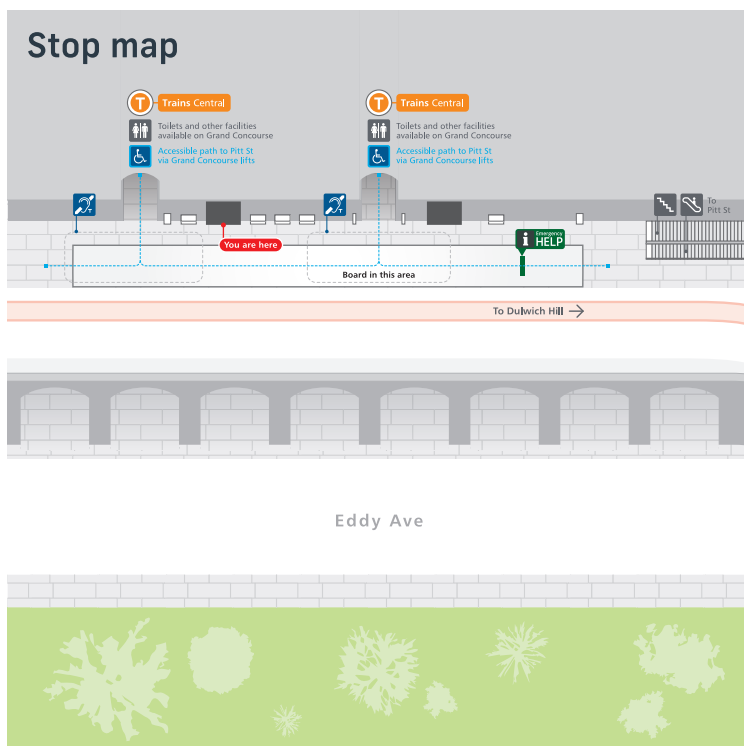


Tap on and tap off, every time. Remember to both tap on and tap off to avoid a fine of up to \$550.00.
